Nature Discovery Programme

WHEN: This free programme runs weekly on a Wednesday from 845am – 1230pm, during term times

PURPOSE: This is a new and exciting opportunity for your tamaiti (child) at Active Explorers Invercargill with the purpose being ‘to explore nature in our local hāpori (community) where they can develop a deeper connection with Papatūānuku (the land) and support their overall wellbeing’.

PHILOSOPHY: The Nui Explorers underlying philosophy is ‘to offer tamariki physical exercise and exploration through unstructured play in nature where they can engage in risk-taking, build their confidence and resilience while challenging their creativity and problem solving skills’. This may include bug hunting, tree climbing, exploring flora and fauna, hut building, basic bushcraft skills and embracing all the seasonal elements!
